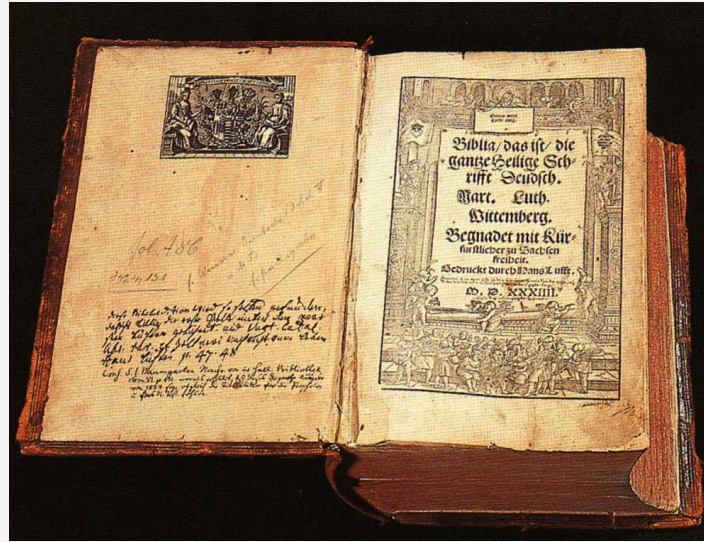


# KEY DATES



- 1483 Born
- 1505 Survived thunderstorm and became a monk
- 1511 Became professor of biblical studies at Wittenberg
- 1517 Nailed ninety-five theses to church door
- 1520 Luther's books burnt; he burnt the pope's bull
- 1521 Diet of Worms: refused to eat recant – 'Here I stand'
- 1534 Published first complete German Bible
- 1546 Died
