Diocesan Synod Nomination Guidance Notes

You may stand for nomination to the Ely Diocesan Synod if you are a member of your parish electoral roll in accordance with the Church Representation Rules, *Section 4: Diocesan Synod, Eligibility: Rule 36.*

- Nominations must be proposed and seconded by current members of Cambridge South Deanery Synod. Details of the parish Deanery Synod representatives can be obtained from the St Martin's Parish Administrator, at the Church Office or by email: office@stm.org.uk

The official information states: *'You will now need to obtain two proposers who are members of your Deanery Synod and the same House as you – Laity for Laity or Clergy for Clergy. Unfortunately, if this is not completed correctly then your nomination will be classed as invalid, so this is a very important step.'*

- If you are currently a member of Diocesan Synod and wish to continue you will need to be re-elected and will also need to fill in a nomination form.
- Completed nomination forms must be returned to the Deanery Secretary by **noon on 21st May 2021.**
